

Full Paper:

Accepted abstracts must be followed by full papers (2000–2500 words) by **31st December 2025**

Format:

- Papers should be prepared in Microsoft Word, using Times New Roman, 12-point font, and 1.5 spacing.
- Follow APA 7th Edition style.

Publication Option:

- Selected papers will be published in an edited volume with ISBN (additional fee applicable).
- Authors should indicate their interest in publication in the registration form.

Guidelines for the Paper Presentation Competition

- Only single-authored papers will be accepted for the competition. If there are two participants (e.g., a researcher and a supervisor), only the presenter will receive the award, while the non-presenter will receive only a certificate of presentation.
- Only research papers will be considered.
- Competition papers must align with the main theme or any one of the sub-themes of the conference.
- The competition entry should be clearly indicated under the paper’s main title.
- The paper presenter must mention his/her willingness to participate in the competition in the registration form.
- No on-the-spot registration for the Paper Presentation Competition.
